To form a 7<sup>th</sup> chord, add a note 2 semitones below the root note of the major chord

Major chord = 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup>

7<sup>th</sup> chord = 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> (add flattened 7<sup>th</sup> note of the major scale)
